standover notes	<p>The tires up there are moderate volume, good ol' tires for these bikes for road riding. Fatter tires will allow lower pressure, softer rides, and bigger bumps in comfort, but will increase standover. R is Radius. Also, shoes add 2cm to your PBH. If you're a crotch-worrier and are in betwixt sizes, go small. If you're not, go big.</p>
